Classes will consist of an introduction to basic pottery skills of pinching, coil-building, slab construction, and throwing on the potter's wheel. The student will also be introduced to various glazing and firing processes. A showcase of students' work will conclude the Session. Mudslingers Pottery Studio is located across from The Dixie at 101 Court Square. Students need to arrive exactly at time scheduled and not more than 5 minutes early since the Instructor will need time to prepare classroom between classes.
